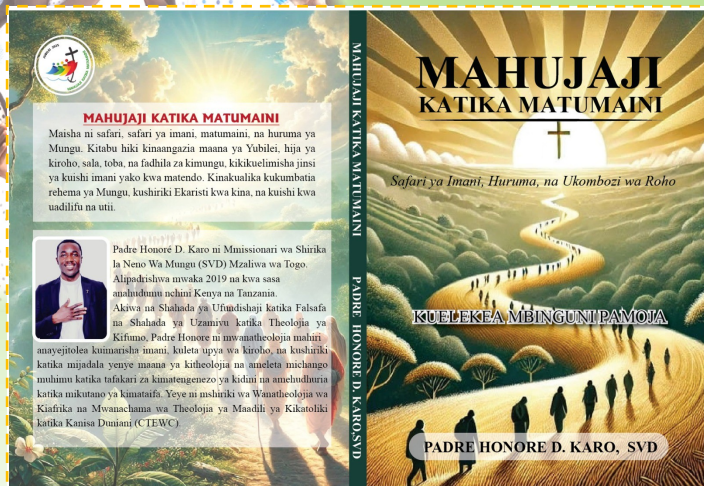


Mission Progress
