Silver Jubilee Easter Monday



During the month of April, Fr. Peddy Castelino, SVD, celebrated his 25th Priestly Anniversary. Fr. Peddy, has served in various capacities in the Archdiocese of Arusha, since he Arrived in Kenya-Tanzania Province in Early 2000s. Currently he working in the Archdiocese of Nairobi, where he is also a Dean.

During his long stay in the province, he has been involved in parish development, sacramental ministry, and community building. He has been actively engaged in mission expansion and pastoral initiatives, including reopening mission areas such as Simanjiro Parish together with other SVD missionaries.
